Format for the day

We will use the Sociocratic principles and facilitation approach which is being adopted by Paramaethu Cymru. This approach was taught at the recent training weekend in Presteigne for Powys Transition Low Carbon Communities. The Transition Network is also keen to adopt Sociocracy in its future development, recognising that it provides

- inclusive facilitation
- dynamic governance via circles
- effective, low-risk decision-making
- maximum engagement at all levels in any organisation

The sessions will be facilitated using these Sociocratic methods so that attendees have a direct experience of the process whilst working on the issues central to them.

Leader: Roz Brown

Roz has a background in Permaculture and management self-development. She teaches Sociocracy to community groups and is currently working with Paramaethu Cymru to embed Sociocracy into its working practice and organisational structure.
